**Subject:** Transportation Options – DoubleTree to Campus

Dear students residing at the DoubleTree hotel,

We are writing to confirm the transportation options available for you to get back and forth to campus during your temporary relocation. UMass Boston shuttle service is close by to connect you to campus as well as the MBTA. The closest shuttle stops, are about a 3-4 minute walk to the hotel:

#### **Temporary Parking Access**
